Vendors Engaged by the Receiver During this Reporting Period Relating to Services to Assist the Receivership in the Development and Delivery of Constitutional Medical Care Within the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (“CDCR”) and its Prisons

During this reporting period, the Receiver has used the substitute contracting process to assist the Office of the Receiver in the development and delivery of constitutional care within CDCR and its prisons. The Receiver has engaged the following vendor for provision of the services noted:

The Receiver used the substitute contracting process to solicit a network of community based specialty health care service providers, a third party administrator for electronic claims processing system, and a new electronic prior authorization system. The Prison Health Care Provider Network is intended to provide access and continuity of care for patients requiring community based specialty care that cannot be provided in the CDCR institutions by CCHCS health care staff and to enable timely processing of claims from those community based providers. Additionally, in order to track and authorize timely access to care, the project includes an electronic prior authorization process.

The expedited formal bid process was used. Proposals were received from Health Net Federal Services, LLC; Cerner HealthPlan Services; and SynerMed (draft proposal).

The contract was awarded to Health Net Federal Services, LLC.
