Consultant(s) will assist CPHCS program and IT staff with development of clinical applications (i.e., Oracle 10g/11g, Oracle Fusion Middleware Suite and Oracle Healthcare Transaction Base [HTB]).

Contractor will report to CPHCS' Deputy Chief Information Officer (DCIO), Clinical Applications, or designee(s). In submitting an offer vendor must comply with the instructions found herein.

3. RFO Page 7, Exhibit A (Statement of Work), Item B.1. (Mandatory Consultant Qualifications), has been deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:
 1. Experience implementing Oracle Fusion Middleware, Initiate eMPI, and Orion Concerto Portal within a single integrated solution; and/or
 2. Experience performing architecting services to implement Business-to-Business (B2B) and Service Oriented Architecture (SOA) solutions using Health Level 7 (HL7) and HTB; and Oracle Security Suite (OAM/OVD/OID); and
 3. Experience implementing Health Transaction Base (HTB) in a mid-to-large size solution (i.e., 1000 users or more).
4. RFO Page 8, Exhibit A (Statement of Work), Item C (Scope of Services), 1st paragraph, has been revised to read:

C. SCOPE OF SERVICES

All services must be approved and agreed to by CPHCS' DCIO, Clinical Applications, or designee, in advance of consultants' performance. Consultants shall perform Oracle Fusion Middleware and Healthcare Transaction Base (HTB) consulting services including, but not limited to, all of the following:

5. RFO Page 8, Exhibit A, Item C.2 has been added as follows:

2. Design and develop Oracle HTB services including, but not limited to, all of the following:
 - Plan and develop the mechanism for data from clinical forms to be stored and retrieved in CPHCS' HTB;
 - Prepare written reports to ensure content and version management of information extracted from the CPHCS' HTB is complete and accurate;
 - Provide technical assistance and/or direct support services to load HL7-based historical data into CPHCS' HTB; and
 - Perform other duties in conjunction with system designers and developers to optimize performance of CPHCS' Oracle system.

QUESTIONS/STATEMENTS AND ANSWERS

1. Question(s)/Statement(s):

"I wanted to know what the max amount for this RFO is."

Answer(s)/Statement(s):

To ensure that rates offered are market driven CPHCS does not disclose budget allotments for Request for Offers.

2. Question(s)/Statement(s):

"I have one qualified consultant for sure that we can submit in our bid response. The RFO addendum calls for two consultants. Can we submit just one consultant on our bid response and be considered for award? The consultant has experience with all three technologies: HTB, Fusion Middleware and HL7."

Answer(s)/Statement(s):

Yes. You may submit an offer for one consultant. However, please note that RFO #10-042-ITS seeks offers for two (2) consultants.

In the event CPHCS determines that services would be best served by awarding multiple agreements for this RFO, CPHCS reserves the right to make this determination and negotiate with Offerors having "best value" to award more than one company and/or firm.

3. Question(s)/Statement(s):

“RFO 10-042-ITS states that HTB is a must, and I am wondering if two people come in for this position as stated on the RFO, is there any flexibility on one having all of the required skills except for the Oracle HTB, specifically?”

Answer(s)/Statement(s):

CPHCS seeks two Oracle consultants. One must have Oracle Fusion Middleware development experience, and another must have at least Oracle Healthcare Transaction Base (HTB) experience. Consultants must have experience with either one or both Oracle Fusion Middleware and Oracle HTB.
